What we're looking for:

If you've got a creative flair and a talent for 3DS Max and a great design eye then we're looking for you. You'll be a creative, driven individual with superb attention to detail who is flexible and works well under pressure. Due to the nature of our industry, a lot of the work can come thick and fast and is inevitably last minute so we'll need someone who can handle this, prioritise workloads and manage internal customers.

You'll work closely with all teams at mclcreate across our network of branches (London, Birmingham, Manchester, Edinburgh and Glasgow) however your base would be either our Manchester or Birmingham office.

It will be a predominately 3d drafting role, creating layouts of events within a particular job environment. This will at times be to the specification advised by the project team but we would also look to you for creating new and engaging designs from scratch. The role will then require you to bring these plans to life within a 3D space, creating photorealistic renders for our customers to understand the concepts/ideas we are proposing. Also at times, you will have to work with client's brands to create content for these renders.

Due to the nature of the live events industry, the drawing tasks will be varied and from time to time there may be the need for site surveys to be carried out to gather detailed venue information. Although day to day tasks will be mostly based on new and existing events, there will be specific tasks required of you around the development and progression of our creative offering.

Primary tasks and responsibilities:

1. Create visuals within 3DS Max of proposed event solutions, clearly conveying initial ideas into workable solutions.
2. Develop conceptual designs and ideas to further enhance our creative offering to clients.
3. Design graphic content, primarily for visuals being produced.
4. When required, carry out site surveys of venues to create accurate layout drawings.
5. Maintain a detailed folder structure of drawings and visuals on the central network for all at mclcreate to use. This will not only include specific event drawings but also venue drawings and general information. You will be responsible for ensuring this is accurate and up to date.
6. Research and extend the mclcreate CAD/3ds block library. This will include both researching online for blocks but also, when not available, measuring equipment and producing accurate drawings from this.

Skills and Competencies:

- Proficient use of 3DS Max software and AutoCAD.
- Good skills in Photoshop and Illustrator would be a distinct advantage, as well as skills across other CS applications.
- Exceptional attention to detail and a great eye for design.
- A desire to show initiative and develop new skills.
- Well organised (manage own workload and workflow).
- Ability to prioritise tasks and manage expectations.
